MODERNISING PAY: DISMISSAL and RE-ENGAGEMENT LETTERS

Everyone who did not sign up on a voluntary basis should have received their dismissal and reengagement letters from the City of Edinburgh Council by now.

It is imperative that you sign that you 'Accept offer of re-engagement' and return this as soon as possible, along with the receipt confirming acceptance of offer (ie you should return the whole of the page headed 'Part 2 for you to sign and return...'). If you do not, your employment with the council will be terminated on 3 October 2010.

The receipt at the bottom of the page will be returned to you by the Council to confirm they have received it. That will mean that, if you signed to accept, your contract will continue with the City of

Edinburgh Council after the 3 October 2010.

If you have not had the receipt returned to you after a week then follow through with your line manager first or by calling the help desk 0131 469 55 55

- Sign the 'accept offer of re-engagement' only in Part 2 and return the whole of that page now. You will still have the right to appeal against your job evaluation outcome after October. Keep 'Part 1' on the previous page for your records.
- Failure to sign and return will result in your contract with the council being terminated.

OUTSTANDING ISSUES

We are continuing to meet with the employer on a weekly basis to discuss outstanding issues in relation to modernising pay e.g. appeals process, temporary staff, part time staff, competency based pay and progression etc and we will issue an update to all members as soon as possible.
